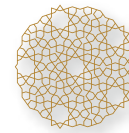

Background: Foundation of Islamic Finance Conference Series, 2006-Ongoing

NOTE: The 12th FIFC meeting is jointly managed by a consortium of five global institutions/universities from Turkiye, Malaysia, Australia and Indonesia together with CFA Society Malaysia, supported by CFA Institute Asia-Pacific Research Exchange ('ARX') and the Emerald Publishing Limited.

The Foundation of Islamic Finance Conference series or FIFC started with a large research funding by the Australian Research Council (ARC) in 2006 to the original team at The University of Melbourne (Prof Abdullah Saeed) and Monash University (Prof Mohamed Ariff & Prof Michael Skully) with the specific aim of creating authentic literature for the then emerging sub-discipline in Finance usually referred widely today as Islamic Finance or as Participatory Finance in some countries. This conference series have been held first as the Inaugural FIFC in 2006 at the University of Melbourne Asia Institute in Australia . The last conference in 2021 was jointly organised by (i) Sunway University Malaysia (ii) INCEIF Malaysia (iii) La Trobe University Australia (iv) Hamad Bin Khalifa University Qatar (v) Istanbul Sabahattin Zaim University Turkey (vi) Istanbul Commerce University Turkey (vii) Istanbul University Turkey and supported by CFA Society Malaysia and Emerald Publishing Limited. The 12th meeting now is occurring in two episodes: a web-based conference over 2 days 01-02 October, 2022 and a face to face meeting at Istanbul on 8-9 October, 2022. The academic society, which is being registered in Australia, will be launched during the Istanbul meeting on 8-9 October, 2022, and all participating delegates to the 11th and 12th conference will become lifetime members of the society.
